COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course introduces students to interpretive philosophies and systematic methods of analysis for the study of the Bible. Students will consider the different aims and assumptions of biblical interpretation, familiarize themselves with the most significant scholarly resources in the field, and demonstrate proficiency in interpreting various biblical texts from both testaments while paying close attention to the social, cultural, and theological contexts of the biblical world and contemporary reader.
