

Comparing this to the national average growth for the past five years of just 16%...we've experienced almost *double* that level of growth.



This year, we have also made adjustments to the academic structure to reflect more clearly the variety of programs we offer. Three divisions, each overseen by a distinct faculty committee, form the new university structure. The Undergraduate division is home to the Bachelor of Arts in Religion program, which offers a major in Biblical Studies and three minors: Ministry, Biblical Counseling, and Christian Worldview.

The four Master of Arts programs are now in the

Graduate Programs division. These 36-hour degree programs are the Master of Arts in Leadership, the Master of Arts in Apologetics, the Master of Arts in Biblical Counseling, and the Master of Arts in Christian Studies.

The third academic division is the Seminary, which includes traditional seminary degrees, the Master of Divinity and the Doctor of Ministry. This new academic structure brings clarity to our current degree offerings while making room for future growth.
