50th Anniversary Matching Scholarship Campaign exceeds Initial Goal By 58%

By God's grace, it was the most successful campaign in Luther Rice history!

Think of the students whose lives will be impacted by the scholarships — and the lives they will further impact when they enter ministry! What a difference you've made for so many.

The campaign began in 2011 with a goal of \$200,000 for scholarships — and ended last December with a total of \$315,713. This is an amazing answer to prayer and testament to the generous hearts of our Luther Rice family.

The campaign included a \$100,000 matching challenge made possible by the efforts of the Board of Trustees, faculty, staff, and other key contributors — this fund also played a key role in the tremendous results.

It is truly astounding to consider the fact that the campaign was accomplished during one of the most



challenging economic times in recent American history.

May God bless everyone who made sacrificial gifts to Luther Rice to assist students in their study of the Word of God.

Right now, we are providing 122 students with over \$145,000 in scholarship funds. That's about 10% of the total student body.

Thankfully God has also provided friends we call

"Support Partners," who pledge to give regularly for scholarship funding.

he Bible makes it clear — a father's faithfulness can bless his family line for generations!

This has certainly happened for Harper Bumpers and his family. He became a born again Christian in 1970, at the age of 35 ... and actually moved his family to Jacksonville, Florida in 1971 so he could attend Luther Rice Seminary (when the institution was still in Jacksonville).

Harper earned a Bachelor's degree, a Master of Divinity (M.Div.) degree, and a Doctor of Ministry (D. Min.) degree, all from Luther Rice.

Road Baptist Church in Jacksonville, where he has been the pastor for 40 years!

Harper's son, Eddie was nine years old when his family moved to Jacksonville.

Like his father, he attended Luther Rice for his Bachelor's degree, later earning his Master of Arts degree.

And, Harper's wife, Tess, even served as Dr. Flanagan's secretary while Eddie attended school.

When Eddie became a pastor in Missouri at Broadway Baptist Church, he realized he needed

more education — but this time distance learning was the best answer. He pursued his M.Div. online with Luther Rice, and graduated in 2010.

Not surprisingly, Eddie's son Jared also sensed a calling to ministry — and although he attended Baptist Bible College for his Bachelor's degree, God laid on his heart to pursue a M.Div. degree at Luther Rice. He graduated with his Master's at the same time his father did, in 2010.

Today, both Jared and Eddie are now pursuing their Doctorate in Ministry degrees from Luther Rice.

"This study has tremendously enhanced my expository preaching," Eddie says.

Father and son will graduate together in May 2013 with their D. Min. degrees.

Today, Eddie and Jared serve at the same church, Crossway Baptist Church in Springfield, Missouri, formerly called Broadway Baptist Church. Eddie has served as the senior pastor for the last 12 years while Jared has served as Student Minister for five years.

The church built a brand-new facility at a different location last year — and has already had to expand to two Sunday services. By God's grace, the church has grown from 150 people to 1600 members during Eddie's pastorate.

The Bumpers family story is an inspiring and Godhonoring legacy. It is a blessing to see how God can completely transform a family line for His Kingdom when one father comes to Christ. This family story is an excellent example of how Luther Rice students reach out with the Gospel for generations to come. To God be the Glory!
