new degrees and certificates!**




The **Undergraduate and Graduate Certificate** courses are completed within the institution's 15-week spring/fall semesters and 11-week summer semester. You can complete the 9-hour (3 courses) programs in as little as 15 weeks by taking 3 courses in one semester. Need more time? Take one course a semester and finish in 3 semesters (1 year). Your choice.



The **Bachelor of Arts in Psychology** exists to lead students in applying psychological knowledge under the authority of Scripture to the mental, physical/emotional, spiritual, and relational needs of people in the marketplace and church/missional settings.

The degree provides a comprehensive biblically based curriculum with a psychology major and biblical counseling minor supported by general education foundations, biblical and theological studies, and applications to both the marketplace and ministry.



The **81-hour Master of Divinity Program** was designed with our students in mind. The program is not simply shorter for the sake of time but rather crafted to include courses that are unique to the marketplace and will prepare the student for their calling to the ministry.

TIPS PRIOR TO REGISTERING!

- Fulfill the requirements for any outstanding incomplete grades
- Access and view online status sheet before registering
- Pay appropriate fees

Incomplete Grade

I-Grade may be assigned only if the student has been unable to complete the course because of unavoidable circumstances. The reason for an "Incomplete" must be approved by the professor of the course and shall be noted on all grade reports. A course in which the student received a grade of "I" must be completed within 30 days after the end of a semester unless special permission is granted by the instructor and the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Failure to complete the work within those time limits will result in the grade earned by the student at that time. Merely failing to complete the work on time is not a legitimate justification for the use of "I."

DID YOU KNOW?

Independent Studies

Independent study requests are primarily approved in the spring semester for those students who need the course to graduate.

Independent Studies may be defined as study (being pursued for course credit) which is under the direct supervision of an appropriate faculty member and is completed in the same time frame of a normal semester.

Repeating a Course

Luther Rice follows a non-punitive course of remediation in which a student may repeat a course that was taken at Luther Rice and received a grade of "D" or "F" and have only the second grade calculated in the cumulative grade point average. The course repeated will have the original grade replaced with an "R" and a new course entry will be placed on the transcript showing the second grade.

Students within a Master of Arts degree program must earn a letter grade of "C" or higher. A student who receives a "D" or "F" must repeat the course. Students within the Doctor of Ministry degree program must earn a letter grade of "B" or higher. A student who receives a "C," "D," or "F" must repeat the course.

Program Time Limitations

- For-credit Certificates (9 hours) 1 semester - 1 year
- BA degree (120 hours) 2-10 years
- MA degrees (36 hours) 1-3 years
- M.Div. degree (90 hours) 2-7 years
- D.Min. (30 hours) 3-5 years
